1. What is BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel and what is used for

BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel contains cannabinoids and terpenes. It is part of the BREAVIX product series optimized for supporting breast cancer patients. The OncoRix products series was designed to support oncological patients as part of an "Integrative Oncology" approach and is based on botanic combinations that are tailored to ease the side effects associated with conventional medicinal treatments. The series includes cannabis-based and mushroom-based products that can be combined.

2. What you need to know before using BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel

Warnings and precautions

Do not use this product if you:

- Are receiving tamoxifen.
- Are taking immunosuppressants (Corticosteroids, Calcineurin inhibitors, mTOR inhibitors, IMDH inhibitors, -Monoclonal antibodies)
- Are allergic to cannabis or any of the other ingredients listed on the label of this product.
- Have a history of drug dependence.
- Have been diagnosed with schizophrenia or suffer from psychotic episodes.
- Are currently pregnant, or breast-feeding.

Check with your doctor if you:

- Are taking other medications, including non-prescription medicines and dietary supplements.
- If anyone directly related to you has any mental health problems such as schizophrenia, psychosis or other significant psychiatric disorder
- If you have kidney problems
- If you have moderate to severe liver problems
- If you have a serious heart problem such as angina, a previous heart attack, poorly controlled high blood pressure or a problem with your heart rate or heartbeat

Alcohol and BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel

Combining alcohol with BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel should be avoided (especially at the beginning of treatment or when changing dose) as it may increase effects such as drowsiness, sedation, loss of balance or ability to respond quickly, which could increase the risk of falls and other accidents.

Driving and using machines

- Do not drive or use machinery when starting to take BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel until you are established on a stable daily dose.
- Do not drive or use machinery if BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel causes you effects such as sleepiness, dizziness or any effects that could impair your ability to perform

these tasks. If you are not sure, do not drive or operate machines.

Travel with BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel

BREAVIX CANNABIS OIL SOFTGEL contains ingredients that are illegal under federal law. You cannot use or possess this product on federal lands or take it across state lines.

3. How to use BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel

- Capsules should be swallowed whole, not chewed.
- It is recommended to take BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel with food
- The maximal recommended dose is 4 capsules per day

When you first start using BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel, follow the amounts specified in the table below to gradually reach the recommended daily amount.

If you start to feel unwanted effects do not increase the dose until you no longer feel these effects. If possible, continue increasing the dose to reach the optimal recommended daily amount.

4. Possible side effects

Side effects associated with approved cannabis based medical products or medicines are more likely to occur when your treatment first starts. In most cases side effects are quite mild and they generally wear off within a few days.

All medicines, including medicinal cannabis can have side effects. The extent of effects can vary with the type of medicinal cannabis product and between individuals.

As a guide, side effects of approved cannabis based medicines include the following, but this list is not exclusive:

Stop taking and speak to your doctor or go to a hospital straight away if you notice any of the following serious side effects as you will need to be monitored until the symptoms stop:

- seeing or hearing things that are not there (hallucinations).
- believing ideas that are not true.
- feeling that other people are against you.
- thoughts of suicide.
- feeling depressed or confused.
- feeling over-excited or losing touch with reality

Other possible side effects:

Diarrhea, Dizziness, Memory problems, Mood swings, Mouth dryness, Vivid dreams, Stomach pain, Blurred vision, Decreased concentration, Anxiety, Tiredness, Nausea and/or vomiting, Panic

5. How to store BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel

- Do not use this product after the expiry date shown on the product packaging.
- Store BREAVIX Cannabis oil softgel in its container in a refrigerator (2°C to 8°C).
- Keep this product out of the sight and reach of children.

6. Content of the pack and other information

Each capsule contains: THC 2.5 mg, CBD 33.7 mg, CBDA 33.7 mg, CBDV 54.8 mg, β -Caryophyllene, Limonene, Linalool, b-Myrcene, α -Pinene

The other ingredients (excipients) are: Grapeseed Oil, D-Sorbitol, GELITA® Enteric Coating.
